


The Decorating Committee will again be decorating the sanctuary at Christmas with live red Poinsettias.

Wheeler Study



During the month of December KBC will receive the Retired Ministers & Missionaries Offering (RMMO).

The Retired Ministers and Missionaries Offering supports retired ministers, missionaries and their widowed spouses who have devoted 15 or more years of their lives to service in American Baptist Churches USA.

For all they've done for us, let's thank our faithful pastors and missionaries. "I thank my God every time I remember you." (Philippians 1:3)

Giving to the Retired Ministers and Missionaries Offering is one tangible way to say "Thank you for..." all the ways ministers and missionaries have helped guide you along your spiritual journey.

This offering supports those who have devoted their lives to God's service by providing emergency assistance in their times of need and a Thank You check at the end of each year. With gift revenue from the RMMO 2022 offering, we distributed 3,332 thank you checks averaging \$154, a modest amount in which the gesture says far more than the dollars. For all the Goodness they've brought, let's do this for them again this year.

RMMO recipients have used their funds to:

- Pay for medical expenses not covered by Medicare, such as hearing aids, dental services, and vision care;
- Purchase prescription medication not covered under health insurance; and
- Make emergency home repairs.

Envelopes are located on the table in the back of the sanctuary. Checks can be made payable to Kenmore Baptist Church with RMMO written in the note section of the check.
